These animal crowns are perfect for your child for playing pretend, acting out stories, or sharing with friends at celebrations. Help your child color, cut, and create these crowns while Playing With a Purpose.

What you'll need:

- Scissors
- Crayons, colored pencils, or markers
- 8 1/2 x 11 white paper (for printing)
- Glue, glue stick, or tape



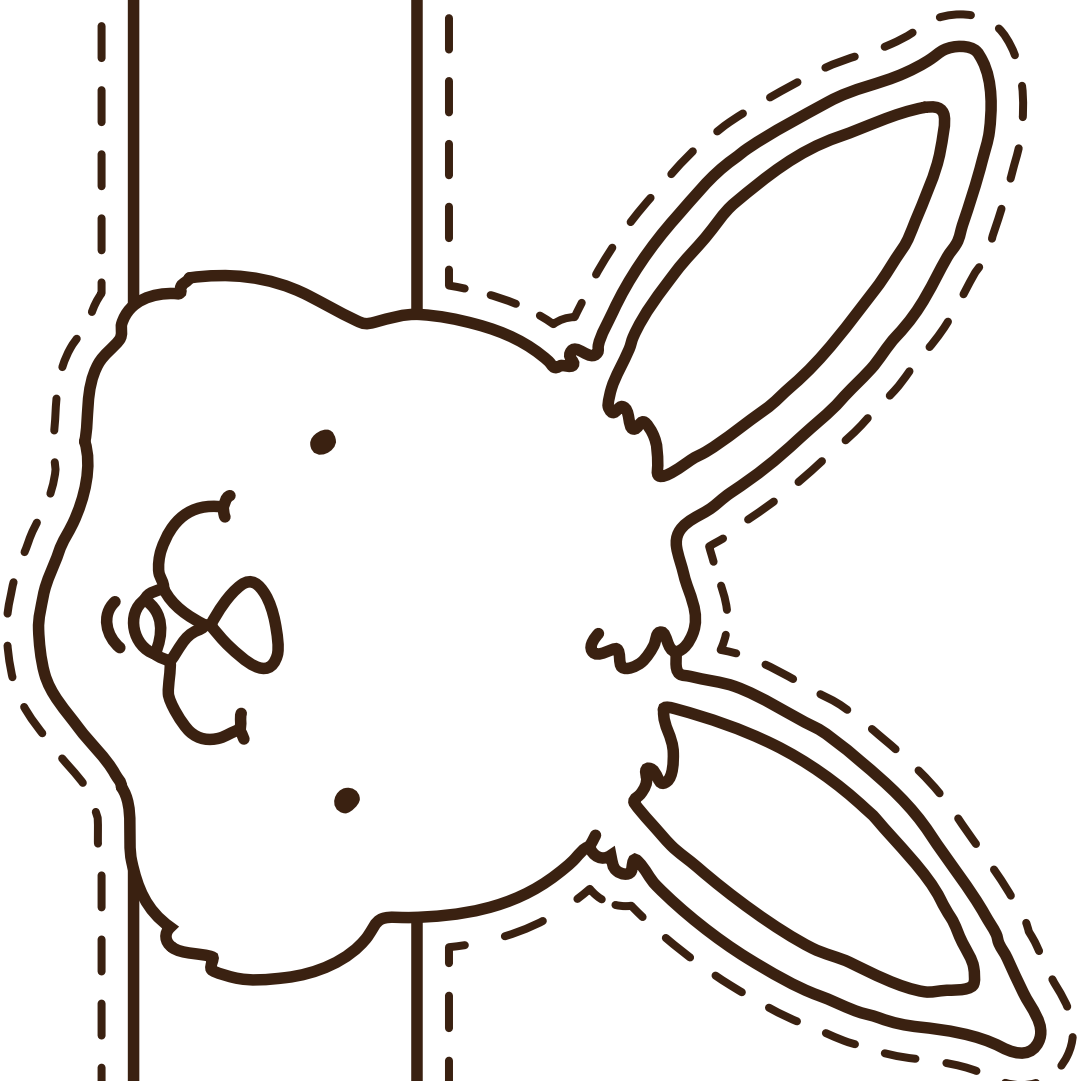
INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAREGIVER AND CHILD:

1. Print out the animal crowns.
2. Have your child pick an animal and color the face with crayons, colored pencils, or markers.
3. Cut out the crown and headband along the dotted lines. If your child can cut by themselves, ask them to practice their scissor skills by cutting out the animal's face and headband. If they are not ready to use scissors, you can hold their hand and cut the pieces together.
4. Help your child glue or tape the headband to the tab on one side of the animal's face. Once it has dried, place the headband around your child's head to the other tab on the animal's face. Adjust the headband for size and glue or tape the headband in place.
5. Ask your child to pretend to be the animal. What sounds does it make? How does it walk and move? Make up a story about the animal and act out that story.

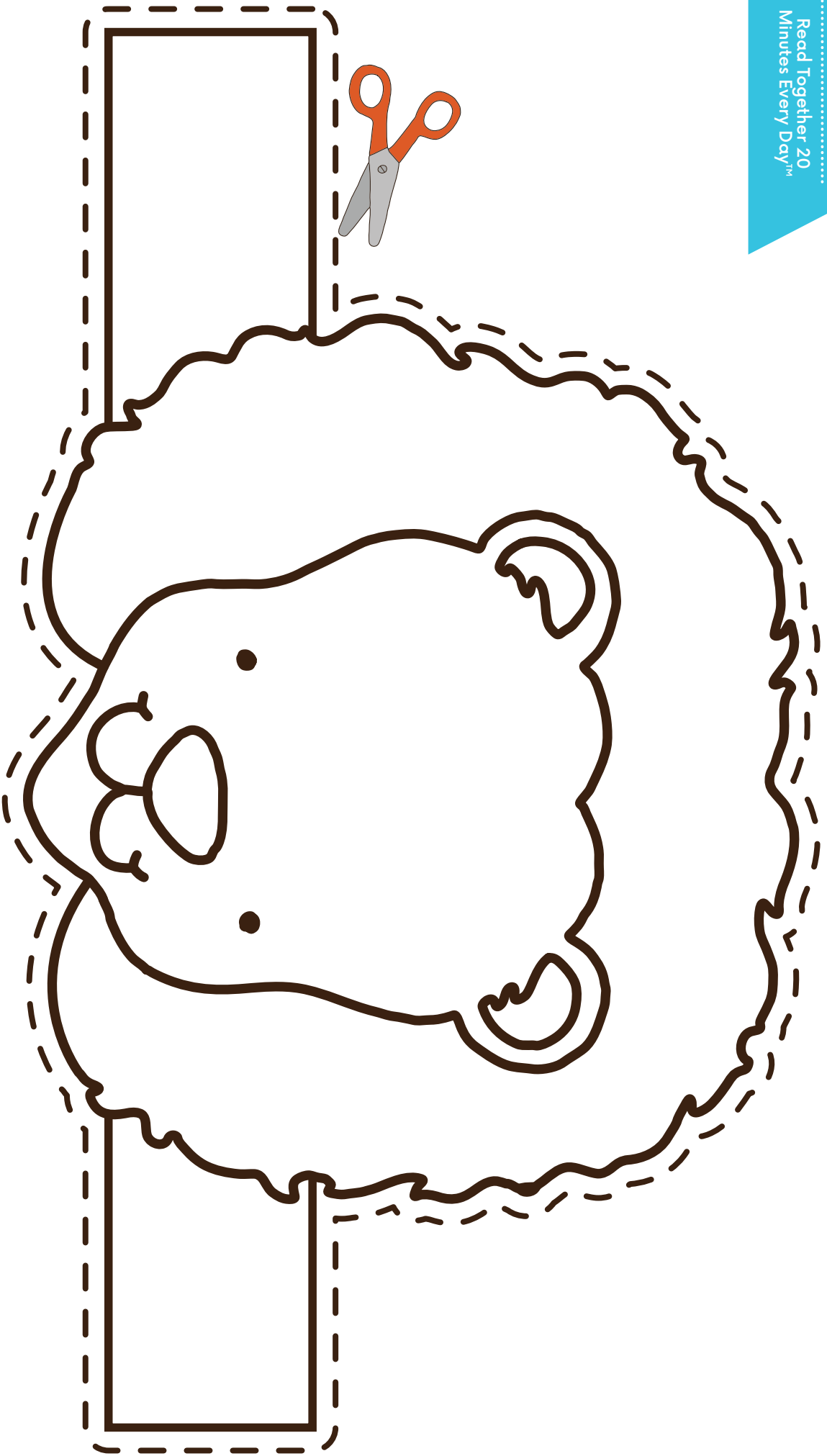

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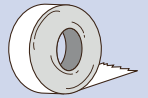
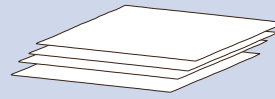
AMAZING ANIMALS BOARD GAME



Play With a Purpose with your child with this easy-to-play board game. Your child will learn the names of five different animals as well as the colors of the rainbow, in addition to following directions. It's fun for the whole family!

What you'll need:

- 8½ x 11 white cardstock paper or regular paper (for printing)
- Scissors
- Tape



INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAREGIVER AND CHILD:

1. Print out the Amazing Animals game board, cards, and animal pieces.
2. Cut out the playing cards and animal pieces. If your child can cut by themselves, ask them to practice their scissor skills by cutting out the playing cards and animal pieces. If they are not ready to use scissors, you can hold their hand and cut the pieces together.
3. Help your child fold the bottom of the animal game pieces and tape the bottom to create a stand.
4. Have your child tape the two game boards together. Trim the edges as necessary to align the two pieces of the board together.

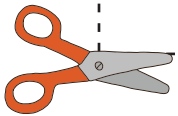







1. Ask the players to each choose an animal game piece and place it on Start.
