

Kwanzaa is celebrated December 26 to January 1 to honor African culture and heritage. The kinara (Swahili for candle holder) is used during the week of Kwanzaa to represent the seven principles of Kwanzaa.

1. Color the large, middle candle of the kinara BLACK to symbolize African people.

2. Color the first three candles of the kinara RED to represent the struggle of African people.

3. Color the last three candles of the kinara GREEN to represent the hope and future the comes from African people's struggle.
