FUN POINTILLISM MASTERPIECES!



Create dazzling works of art using the technique of pointillism. Help your child use different colored child-friendly paints and cotton swabs to create small dots to fill in the shapes of fun animals with this paint-by-number activity.

What you'll need:

- Cotton swabs
- Paints

COLOR KEY:

Red = 1

Yellow = 2

Blue = 3

Brown = 4

Black = 5

Pink = 6

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAREGIVER AND CHILD:

- 1. Dip cotton swab into a small container of paint with the corresponding number.
- 2. Use the cotton swab to make a dot on the paper.
- 3. Repeat by putting a new dot next to the first dot.
- 4. Continue until the section is full of dots.
- 5. Some sections may have two numbers. Used the two numbers and their colors to mix the dots together.
- **Don't have paints at home? No problem. Thick markers can also be used instead of paint and cotton swabs.

Making crafts and doing activities is always fun! But remember, **Playing With a Purpose** is being actively engaged in your child's play. These activities are intended to enjoy together at the same time you ensure your child's safety and offer help as needed.
