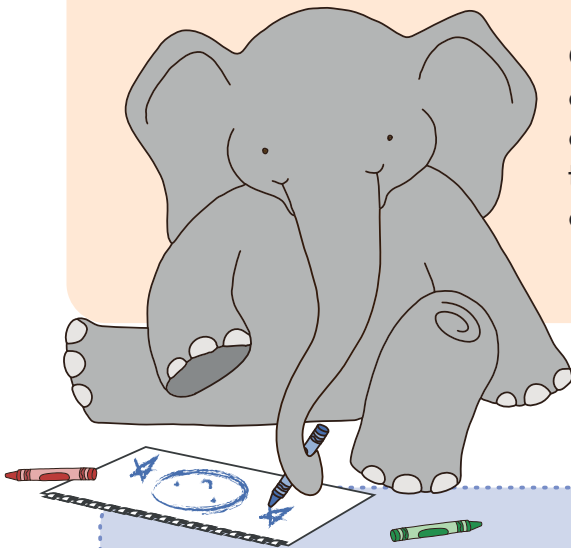

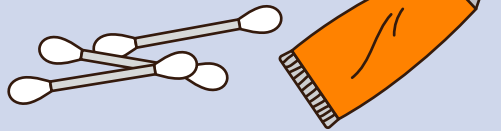
Read Together 20

Create dazzling works of art using the technique of pointillism. Help your child use different colored child-friendly paints and cotton swabs to create small dots to fill in the shapes of fun animals with this paint-by-number activity.

What you'll need:

- Cotton swabs
- Paints



COLOR KEY:

- Red = 1
- Yellow = 2
- Blue = 3
- Brown = 4
- Black = 5
- Pink = 6

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAREGIVER AND CHILD:

1. Dip cotton swab into a small container of paint with the corresponding number.
2. Use the cotton swab to make a dot on the paper.
3. Repeat by putting a new dot next to the first dot.
4. Continue until the section is full of dots.
5. Some sections may have two numbers. Used the two numbers and their colors to mix the dots together.

**Don't have paints at home? No problem. Thick markers can also be used instead of paint and cotton swabs.

Making crafts and doing activities is always fun! But remember, **Playing With a Purpose** is being actively engaged in your child's play. These activities are intended to enjoy together at the same time you ensure your child's safety and offer help as needed.
